

### ONLINE RESOURCES

- **Online Journals** -- E-journals may be accessed by selecting **Beaumont-Dearborn Journal List** from the “Books & Journals” drop-down menu on the library’s home page. This resource provides access to more than 10,000 online journals, including non-medical titles, via several databases. Many of these journals are accessible only from Beaumont facilities.
- **Online Books** -- E-books can be accessed via the **e-BOOKS BY SUBJECT** on the library homepage. You can also search for e-books in the **Library Catalog** located under the “Books & Journals” drop-down menu.
- **AccessMedicine** -- Provides access to about 80 medical texts (including **Harrison's Principles of Internal Medicine**), thousands of images, interactive self-assessment, case files, diagnostic tools, and a comprehensive search platform.
- **CINAHL PLUS with FULL TEXT** (Cumulative Index of Nursing and Allied Health Literature) -- The world's most comprehensive nursing & allied health research database, provides indexing for more than 5,000 journals, dating back to 1937. The full text for more than 760 journals, 275 books/monographs, 130 Evidence-Based Care Sheets and nearly 170 Quick Lessons is included.
- **ClinicalKey** -- ClinicalKey is a clinical search engine providing health professionals with access to current medical literature, including journals, e-books, videos, practice guidelines, and patient education handouts. ClinicalKey includes access to hundreds of journals and over a thousand e-books. Contact the library to set up remote access, which will allow you to use the site from your home computer or mobile device.
- **Cochrane Databases / Cochrane Library** -- This suite of databases contain high-quality, independent evidence to facilitate health care decision-making. It includes: Cochrane Central Register of Controlled Trials, Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews, Database of Abstracts of Reviews of Effects (DARE), Cochrane Methodology Register, Health Technology Assessments Database, and NHS Economic Evaluation Database.
- **Lippincott Advisor**-- A collection of evidence-based content that provides practicing nurses with instant access to online references at the point of care. Users can quickly and easily locate information by browsing by topic or category, or searching for a specific subject.
- **Lippincott Procedures** -- Provides detailed descriptions of procedures, allowing users to locate specific procedures quickly and easily through an alphabetical list or browsing by discipline.
- **Micromedex** -- Provides quick access to information on diseases, toxicology, and drugs. It includes features to assist with drug comparison, drug identification, therapeutic class searching, and dosing. Helpful laboratory tools and conversion calculators are also available within this resource.
- **PubMed** -- An online database from the National Library of Medicine that provides access to millions of citations in the Medline database and other life science journals and online books. PubMed covers the fields of biomedicine, health, life sciences, behavioral sciences, chemical sciences, and bioengineering. By using the link on the library website you will be able to access Beaumont-Dearborn’s e-journals directly from Pubmed.
- **STAT!Ref** -- Provides access to the full text of over 40 nursing and medical reference books. Additional tools include **Stedman’s Medical Dictionary**, **EBMcalc** (an array of medical formulae, clinical criteria sets and decision tree analysis tools), **ICD-10** and ACP’s **PIER**, a point-of-care decision support tool consisting of over 400 evidence-based modules.

- **UpToDate** --A clinical decision support resource designed to be used at point-of-care. UpToDate covers 23 specialties and includes more than 10,500 topic reviews. UpToDate also includes drug information, patient information, medical calculators, and continuing education credit.

## LITERATURE SEARCH SERVICES

- Mediated literature searches, by librarians, are available for Beaumont-related search topics. Most searches are completed within 24 hours. Clinical emergencies/urgent requests receive immediate attention. Search requests can be made by email to [medlibrary@beaumont.org](mailto:medlibrary@beaumont.org), and by phone or fax.
- Librarians are available to assist with searching databases to locate information for CAP or school projects.
- **Automatic Monthly Update** -- If you have an ongoing research interest, we can store your literature search and have it run on a monthly basis against the new citations being loaded into the database. Therefore, you get a list of the newly published articles on your topic.
